There will be some meetings to help explain this process more fully.

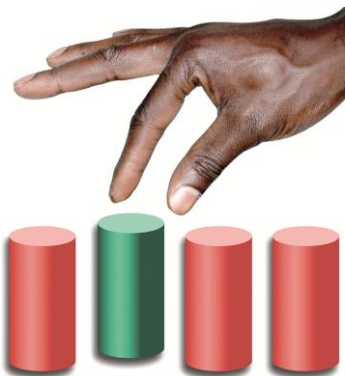

Beverley Tarka is Interim Director for Adult Social Care.

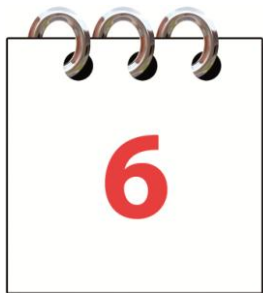

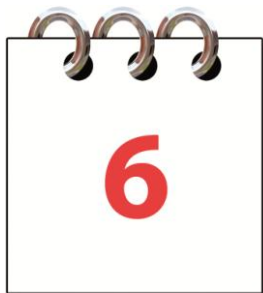
